Resolution #009 Method of Determining Basis for Additional Membership Dues

Whereas members of The Northern Forum represent diverse socioeconomic backgrounds.

Whereas the current method of determining additional membership dues may be considered inequitable for some members.

Whereas additional membership dues may be required above the base fee of \$10,000 U.S.D. funds (annually).

Whereas no member region shall pay more than 25% of any additional assessment.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Board of Directors of The Northern Forum hereby agree to adopt a formula based on the Gross Regional Product (G.R.P) and the 25% maximum contribution rule.

Alaska	5,000,000	500,000	4,500,000

Total G.R.P
combined for all regions Divided by: Alaska's G.R.P.
After Reduction = 15%

\$30,000,000 \$4,500,000

Additional
Amount Assessed Multiplied by: 15% = **\$15,000.**
