

Resolution #52
Concerning Support for Guidelines for Wildlife Management in
Northern Regions

Whereas the Northern Forum adopted the Project for Establishing Guidelines for Wildlife Management, which was proposed by Hokkaido at the 1991 Founding General Assembly as a priority project,

Whereas four consecutive meetings of the Project Committee were held, including the first committee meeting in Hokkaido in 1993, to discuss objectives, systems and measures among other factors, to ensure adequate wildlife management in northern regions in the futures,

Whereas representative of participating regions finalized Guidelines for Wildlife Management and established the Guidelines, which are common to northern regions, at the fourth project committee meeting in Yakutsk, Sakha Republic, Russia, in June 1996,

and whereas the project committee requested that all members of the Northern Forum endeavor to discuss and undertake measures necessary to promote wildlife management in accordance with the above mentioned guidelines,

be it resolved that the Board of Directors of the Northern Forum support attached Guidelines for Wildlife Management and endeavor to take measures to realize the Guidelines.
