Concerning the 6th Northern Forum General Assembly

Issue:

Different members of the Northern Forum host General Assemblies every two years. The locations of these events rotate among the Geographical Areas of the Northern Forum (Northern Europe, Russia, East Asia and North America). In 1995, Hokkaido hosted a General Assembly; in 1997, the Sakha Republic (Yakutia) hosted the event; Lapland hosted it in 1999; and Alberta hosted a 10th Anniversary and 5th General Assembly in 2001.

2003 will mark the 300th anniversary of the founding of the City of Saint Petersburg, Russia, and the City has indicated it would like to host the 6th General Assembly of the Northern Forum in Russia.

Recommendation:

The Executive Committee recommends that the Board of Governors welcome and accept the kind offer of St. Petersburg to host the 6th biannual General Assembly in 2003.

Be It Resolved, by the Board of Governors of the Northern Forum:

That the Northern Forum hereby welcomes and accepts the kind offer of the City of St. Petersburg to host the 6th biannual General Assembly of the Northern Forum in the year 2003.
