# ABOUT REGIONAL COORDINATORS COMMITTEE MEETING

---





The regular Regional Coordinators Committee meeting was held in Khanty-Mansiysk from June 29 to June 30, 2017. The meeting was organized by the Northern Forum Secretariat and Krasnoyarsk Krai jointly with the Office of External Relations of Department of Public and External Relations of Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug - Ugra. The meeting was combined with Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug - Ugra Governor's Cup International Oblas Rowing Competitions within the framework of traditional Vit Khon Hatl festival in Nefteyugansky district, which took place on July 1, 2017.

The two main items on meeting's agenda were the strategy and project activities of the Northern Forum. For strategy discussions, Innovation Camp group work under Lapland moderation was carried out. While, project activities were considered at the Roundtable of the Northern Forum Working groups Chairs and the Northern Forum project participants.

8 regional coordinators from Krasnoyarsk Krai, Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug, Sakha Republic (Yakutia), Akureyri, Lapland, Kamchatka Krai, Chukotka Autonomous Okrug and Nenets Autonomous Okrug were represented at the meeting. Moreover, a potential NF member region - Arkhangelsk Oblast – took part. In addition to the regional coordinators, representatives of the Northern Forum member regions, experts, participants in the project activities of the organization, chairs and the Northern Forum Working group members (see Annex 2 for the full list of participants) attended the meeting.

# FIRST DAY OF THE MEETING

JUNE 29, 2017 (THURSDAY)



The first day of the Regional Coordinators Committee meeting was opened by the Chair of Regional Coordinators Committee, Vice-Chairman of the Government of Krasnoyarsk Krai Yuriy Zakharinskiy.

## Information on the activities of the Northern Forum

Up-to-date information on activities of the organization and events that took place after the Northern Forum Governors' Meeting in Arkhangelsk within the Arctic International Forum "Arctic: Territory of Dialogue" on March 30, 2017, was presented by the Executive Director of the Northern Forum Mikhail Pogodaev. Following the results of the meeting in Arkhangelsk, numerous recommendations were received from the heads of regions, and ideas on Northern Forum's further development and work directions were expressed. Initiatives and project proposals voiced in Arkhangelsk by governors will be considered during the General Assembly of the Northern Forum in Krasnoyarsk in November 2017.

Mikhail Pogodaev stressed that in the near future expansion of the Northern Forum membership is possible, given that two regions - Arkhangelsk Oblast and Khabarovsk Krai are considering joining the Northern Forum. In addition, two applications for a business partnership were received from the Arctic Portal (Iceland) and UIC Arctic Business Relations LLC from Ukpeagvik Inupiat Corporation (USA).

During the reporting period, the Northern Forum took part in following events:

Also, during the reporting period, project activities were actively implemented, in particular:

- Youth Ecological Forum "Arctic is our home" was held in Salekhard, Russia on April 13-16
- The Northern Forum participated in the book publication entitled "EALLU: Indigenous Youth, Arctic Change & Food Culture"
- In June, International

Environmental Action “To Save and Preserve” was held in Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug

- Contacts made with Ukpeagvik Iñupiat Corporation (Alaska) to implement reindeer herding reintroduction project in Barrow, Alaska, USA

- Together with the Arctic Portal and in cooperation with the Arctic Economic Council, the Arctic Business Directory is being created

- Together with the Arctic Portal, Northern Forum website modernization work is ongoing.

## The Northern Forum Strategy Innovation Camp

After the Northern Forum Executive Director’s presentation, the Northern Forum strategy was discussed under the moderation of the Manager for International Cooperation of the Regional Council of Lapland Kristiina Jokelainen and the Chair of the Regional Coordinators Committee Yuriy Zakharinskiy.

Before the discussion of the strategy, presentations were made by experts - Professor of the University of Lapland Lassi Heininen and Director of the Arctic Portal Halldór Jóhannsson, as well as the County Governor of Lapland Mika Riipi and the Executive Director of the Northern Forum Mikhail Pogodaev.



**Lassi Heininen** in his speech about sub-national governments of the global Arctic and paradiplomacy influencing world politics noted that the current state of stability in the Arctic, along with the rapid changes occurring in the region, and new economic interests in the Arctic, have transformed the Arctic region into a major player in world politics and the global economy. He also expressed the idea that Arctic subnational players are actively changing their role in the field of policy-making and regional governance.



**Halldór Jóhannsson**, who spoke about the Northern Forum as key to increased knowledge, cooperation, adaptability and resilience in the Arctic, said that cooperation and strong relationship contribute to a better understanding. A well-designed website is important for the dissemination of information and materials of the Northern Forum. In addition, Halldór Jóhannsson expressed the need for funding for more active participation of the Northern Forum in international cooperation, and expressed his view on the importance of forming the vision of the Northern Forum and setting goals for its achievement.



**Mikhail Pogodaev** presented a brief overview of the work on the strategy of the Northern Forum that has been done to date. At the XII General Assembly of the Northern Forum in Yakutsk, discussion of the organization's strategy was initiated. A small group of experts was formed to develop the basic document. As a result, three concept papers were formed by the Northern Forum Secretariat, Executive Director of the Institute of the North Nils Andreassen, and Senior Research Associate of the Arctic and Antarctic Research Institute Nadezhda Kharlampieva.

Based on these documents, the following main issues can be singled out:

- Purpose of the organization
- Priority areas of the common interests to the regions
- Reformation of the organizational structure
- Project activities and financing
- Systematization of interaction with business partners
- Working groups of the organization
  - Establishment of regional offices
  - Involving Indigenous Peoples
    - Involving youth
    - Interaction with other international organizations



The speakers spoke in favor of developing a simple and clear strategy paper with the identification of goals, objectives and future directions of activities. This position was supported by **Yuriy Zakharinskiy** due to the presence of other large strategic documents in Russian regions.

According to **Mika Riipi**, at the moment all construction blocks of the Northern Forum's future are already there, the main thing is to put them on a timeline and to reach agreement on priority implementation stages. He singled out several points that, in his opinion, might be worth taking into account when developing the strategy of the Northern Forum:



- Linking the Chairmanship programs in the Northern Forum to the programs of the Arctic Council
- A new financing approach
- Reducing a number of priority activities in conjunction with new working methods and modernization of the Secretariat

# SECOND DAY OF THE MEETING

JUNE 30, 2017 (FRIDAY)

On the second day, a **member of the Federation Council of the Russian Federal Assembly from Chukotka Autonomous Okrug Anna Otke** joined the Regional Coordinators Committee meeting. Anna Otke addressed to the participants a welcoming remarks and wished productive work.

## The Northern Forum Strategy Innovation Camp

The second day of the Regional Coordinators Committee meeting began with presentations of groups and their answers to the four questions raised the day before.

The **first group** was represented by the **County Governor of Lapland Mika Riipi**. In the opinion of the first group, the Northern Forum is already an existing mechanism that allows the voices of the regions to be heard. An important issue is the recognition of the Northern Forum in the international arena and in other Arctic cooperation systems. Recognition of the Northern Forum should be our top priority. It is necessary to strive to involve all Arctic regions in the work of the Northern Forum at various levels, i.e. not only as members, but also as partners of the organization. In addition, the Northern Forum needs to involve indigenous peoples and non-governmental organizations working with them. Also, the group proposes to bind the chairmanship in the Northern Forum to the chairmanship of the Arctic Council.

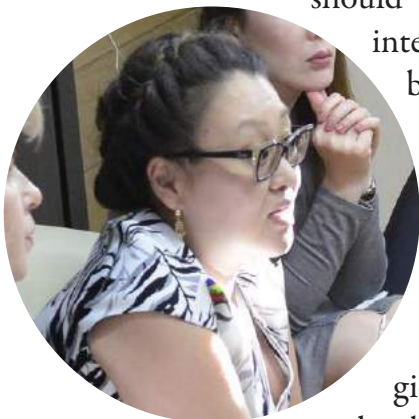


The group identified four issues that could be addressed by the future programs of the Chairmanship in the Northern Forum:

- New ways of functioning and determining the policy of the organization;
- A new approach to the prioritization of the Northern Forum;
- The updated system of financing.

The opinion of the **second group** was presented by the **Acting Deputy Executive Director of the Northern Forum Olga Timofeeva-Tereshkina**. The group expressed the opinion that the Northern Forum is a platform for dialogue, necessary for strengthening the voices of northern regions, understanding the level of responsibility to their regions, increasing trust

between regions, forming a single social and cultural space for future generations and young people, preserving cultural heritage and protecting the environment. The Northern Forum should develop on the basis of an understanding of interdependence. Decisions should be made on the basis of consensus, the programs being implemented should be elected by a majority of votes in the Northern Forum. Development should take place in such areas of activities as youth, ecology, development of agricultural products and business cooperation. The Forum is necessary for the formation of common norms, standards and rules for interregional cooperation, which, with further development, can reach a higher level. All interested and ready-to-work northern regions should be involved in the work of the Northern Forum.v



The discussion results of the **third group** were presented by the **Minister of Economic Development and Trade of Kamchatka Krai Dmitriy Korostelyov**. The group established three areas of cooperation within the framework of the Northern Forum: best practices in the framework of interregional exchange, maintenance of human contacts and development of contacts at the level of the population living in the territories of our regions, acquaintance between the northern regions. The role of interregional cooperation of northern territories is crucial. Such activities should have an applied, socially-oriented nature. In this regard, the thesis was proclaimed about the reduction of the scale of ambitions. It is necessary to continue work within the framework of interregional cooperation in such areas as education and science, business cooperation, indigenous peoples of the North, environmental protection and public organizations. In these areas, it is necessary to establish specific performance indicators, for example, agreements, including interregional ones, contracts, projects, activities, as well as an increase in the number of companies involved in the projects implementation. The work of the Northern Forum should involve all Arctic regions, as well as work to attract institutions and organizations within the regions.



**First Deputy Head of the Department for External Relations of Sakha Republic (Yakutia) Diana Stepanova** announced results of the **fourth group**. Cooperation within the framework of the Northern Forum is necessary for



closer, integrated, broader cooperation. The group voiced the proposal to create international creative teams to study problems by the principle of project management. The development of the Northern Forum is seen in the expansion of the number of participants and the attraction of business to cooperation. The group proposed to consider the possibility of indicating in the fundamental documents of the organization the interest and business opportunities of the circles within the framework of the Northern Forum. It was also asked to identify the member of the Secretariat from the presiding region. The Northern Forum projects must demonstrate concrete results and be implemented in most of the member regions of the Northern Forum. It is necessary to promote projects in the regions and provide greater accessibility, awareness and openness of the Northern Forum for all people living in areas of the organization. It is important to involve business partnerships and more socially-oriented organizations. An establishment of the Economic Council and the Youth Council should be considered for greater youth involvement.



As a result of the organization's strategy discussion, Lapland has expressed readiness to prepare, in collaboration with the Secretariat, the draft Northern Forum Strategy Roadmap in the form of infographics for the next 4-6 years, which will bring together all the proposals made during the work of the Regional Coordinators Committee meeting in Khanty-Mansiysk, as well as ideas voiced out beyond the meeting. The document will contain the further activities of the organization and the direction in which it will move. The Roadmap will be sent to everyone for the discussion, in September a more detailed version of this document should be ready, and at the General Assembly of the Northern Forum in Krasnoyarsk draft strategy should be submitted for discussion and approval.

As a result of the roundtable, suggestions to determine the responsibilities of the Working groups chairs, the projects structure, were made, in particular the Member of the Federation Council from Chukotka Autonomous Okrug Anna Otke proposed to carry out an analysis of already implemented projects to determine the goals for which projects should be emphasized, criteria for selecting projects, and to establish a contest commission that would determine the compliance of projects with the objectives of the Northern Forum on a competitive basis. In addition, it was proposed to hold separate regular meetings of working groups to discuss their current activities.

## Meeting with Deputy Governor of Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug – Ugra Aleksey Zabozlaev

A meeting of the County Governor of Lapland Mika Riipi and the Deputy Governor of Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug - Ugra Aleksey Zabozlaev was held in the Ugra High Technologies Technopark. The main topic was a discussion of prospects and opportunities for stimulating the development of tourism by the State. The parties agreed on further cooperation and exchange of experience in this direction. Following the results of the negotiations, it was decided to organize in the near future a visit of the tourism industry representatives from Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug





- Ugra to the North of Finland to study business approaches that had proved themselves. Furthermore, Mika Riipi received an invitation to visit Khanty-Mansiysk at a time when the city will become the New Year's Capital of Russia from December 2017 to January 2018. During this period, the main events of the New Year's Capital will be held.

## Visit to Ugra Adaptive Sports Centre

A visit to the Ugra Adaptive Sports Centre was organized for the County Governor of Lapland Mika Riipi and Member of the Federation Council of the Russian Federal Assembly from Chukotka Autonomous Okrug Anna Otke at the invitation of the Member of the Council of Federation of the Russian Federal Assembly from Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug Eduard Isakov.

For the guests, demonstration performances on track and field disciplines were organized. Guests were able to see the training of wheelchair basketball athletes, fencing, boccia, as well as novice athletes who only take their first steps in the sport by participating in the "Dream Ski" and "Dream Rollers" rehabilitation programs.

After the completion of demonstration trainings, the participants of the meeting made a general photo, and then the guests were able to discuss common points of contact in the development of adaptive sports and issues of further cooperation over a cup of tea.



## Visit to Ugra State University

Director of the Arctic Portal Halldór Jóhannsson, Professor of the University of Lapland, Chairman of the Steering Committee of the Northern Research Forum Lassi Heininen and Director of the Taimyr College Vera Cherkasova visited the Ugra State University.

The guests learned about directions of the university's work on the "northern" theme and discussed the possibility of participation of the Ugra State University's representatives in several joint scientific programs.

For example, in the APPLICATE consortium, which includes 16 organizations from 9 countries. The main goal of the project is the joint development and implementation of solutions in the field of climate prediction in the Northern regions of the planet. The project is funded by the European Union's Horizon 2020: Research and Innovation Program with over €8 million. Also, Lassi Heininen presented the EU EDU-ARCTIC program, whose goal is to increase the interest and level of knowledge among high school students in the field of exact sciences using the results of scientific research in the Arctic region.



## Closed meeting of the Regional Coordinators Committee

The first question on the meeting's agenda was to determine the theme of XIII General Assembly of the Northern Forum in Krasnoyarsk. Following the discussions, a preliminary theme was approved - "The Northern Forum: Today and Future", as well as a preliminary date of the Assembly - November 23–25, 2017.

Furthermore, resolutions' adoption was discussed. As a result, the following resolutions (see Annex 3) were adopted after comments and revisions by the Regional Coordinators:

# THIRD DAY

JULY 1, 2017 (SATURDAY)

## Ugra Governor's Cup International Oblas Rowing Competitions within Vit Khon Khatl festival

As part of events in Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug, meeting participants visited an annual International Oblas Rowing Competitions, which took place in Nefteyugansky district. The County Governor of Lapland Mika Riipi, Chair of the Regional Coordinators Committee – Vice-Chairman of the Government of Krasnoyarsk Krai Yuriy Zakharinskiy, Executive Director of the Northern Forum Mikhail Pogodaev took part in the opening ceremony of the competition and expressed words of support to all athletes. In addition, the County Governor Mika Riipi with the Governor of Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug - Ugra Natalia Komarova awarded the winners of the mass start competitions.



The event was an opportunity for the Director of the Arctic Portal Halldór Jóhannsson to try his hand at oblas rowing. Together with an experienced rower, Halldor Johannsson had shown good results, and was very impressed.

## Signing the Cooperation Agreement between the Northern Forum and the Ethnosport Federation of Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug - Ugra

Agreement on cooperation in the sphere of ethnosport support and development in northern regions between the Northern Forum and the Ethnosport Federation of Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug – Ugra (see Annex 4) was signed by the President of the Ethnosport Federation Konstantin Soloviev and the Executive Director of the Northern Forum Mikhail Pogodaev. The signing ceremony was attended by the Governor Natalia Komarova, the Northern Forum Regional Coordinators and participants of the Regional Coordinators Committee meeting.

Under the agreement, the parties intend to exchange experiences and best practices in ethnosport development, to attract members and partners of the Northern Forum to participate in relevant activities in the territory of Ugra, to disseminate information about the programs and activities in the field of ethnosport.

In the nearest plans - preparation and signing of a Memorandum of Understanding between the Northern Forum and the Ethnosport World Society (EWS), as well as the establishment of the Standing Advisory Council on the traditional games of indigenous peoples of the North.

## Meeting with the Governor of Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug - Ugra

The meeting discussed the proposals for the further development of the Northern Forum. Governor **Natalia Komarova** expressed the idea of establishing a permanent electronic platform for the communication of Regional Coordinators, experts and citizens who inhabit the regions of the Northern Forum. “If this portal will be provided by a mobile application, it would be possible to realize important crowdsourcing projects. The most active people live in the North. We could use the growing block-chain technology opportunities for funding the Northern Forum programs, use of any, including distributed databases in order to have the Northern Forum projects equipped with modern facilities for their implementation”, - said Natalia Komarova.

Director of the Arctic Portal **Halldór Jóhannsson** also spoke in favor of the importance of information technology. According to him, IT-department of Ugra State University could take an active part in the work of the Arctic business and cultural portal.



The County Governor of Lapland **Mika Riipi** in his speech said that the need in the Northern Forum at the moment is as high as it was during its establishment. One of the main points of the application of our forces should be work on the establishment of the Northern Forum to be a such an organization, which will have a queue of candidates for membership, to become a real player in the Arctic, the voice of the regions. A good example of this level of recognition in the

Governor **Natalia Komarova** also suggested several areas for mutual work. So, she hopes that the coordinators will be interested in Ugra project to create Innovative and Educational Centre in Surgut, on the basis of which the scientific and educational competence focused towards the development of the Arctic and subarctic areas, that is, precisely those regions that participate the Northern Forum. These are different competences related to the



international arena is the Arctic Council, chaired by Finland since this spring. During his stay in Khanty-Mansiysk, Governor visited various institutions and discussed the possibility of cooperation between Lapland and the Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug in the field of tourism, education and sports. Mika Riipi stressed that the importance of the Northern Forum is to create such opportunities for interregional cooperation.

development of production facilities, exploitation of mineral resources, including offshore and “tight” resources, transport infrastructure and work on environmental issues.

Another area for cooperation proposed by the Governor of Ugra, maybe the International Humanitarian Forum for Civil Initiatives, which will be held in Ugra in October this year. **Mikhail Pogodaev** noted



that this forum is a very important area and offered to organize, within the framework of the forum, a separate area for the development of civil society in the North. The member of the Federation Council from Chukotka Autonomous Okrug **Anna Otke** noted that the idea of combining the two sites of the Humanitarian and Northern Forums will contribute to effective study of the best practices of social innovations not only in Russia but also in other northern countries.

“Having visited the Ugra Adaptive Sports Centre, I think it's time, thanks to your rich experience, to go beyond the regions, and to become an interregional center for adaptive physical education, then get to a Russian level. This will allow people not only to live a full life, but also to achieve victories. We will be proud of this. Your experience in

supporting indigenous peoples is invaluable. Perhaps, the district is the only region where there are more than 400 territories of traditional nature management. This indicates that indigenous peoples are masters in this region. And the legislative experience in this area is very interesting” said **Anna Otke**.

Also **Mikhail Pogodaev** addressed to the Governor **Natalia Komarova** with a proposal to hold the next 7th World Congress of Reindeer Herders in 2021 in Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug - Ugra. Governor Natalia Komarova has supported this initiative.

## Expanded meeting of the “Ugra Salvation” Coordinating Council of the Association of Indigenous Peoples of Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug

Ugra Salvation is an associate member of the Russian Association of Indigenous Peoples of the North, Siberia and Far East. The organization currently has more than 3 million members. The organization aims at consolidating the indigenous peoples of the Ugra, protection of their habitat, preservation of ethnic identity, way of life and culture of the Khanty, Mansi and Nenets people.

The meeting was attended by the Executive Director of the Northern Forum, **Mikhail Pogodaev**, President of the organization **Lyudmila Alferova**, Vice-Presidents of the Organization, Member of the Legislative Assembly of Yamalo-Nenets Autonomous Okrug - Ugra, President of the “Yamal to

descendants” NGO **Eduart Yaungad**, President of “Ugra Herders Union” **Stepan Kechemov**. The meeting discussed a number of issues, including the holding of regional and district celebrations, devoted to the Day of the Fisherman, the organization of the youth forum for indigenous Ugra peoples, the changes in the current Khanty language alphabet, participation in the Congress of Finno-Ugric Peoples of Russian Federation, which will be held this autumn in Syktyvkar.

Coordinating Council praised the idea of holding the next 7th World Congress of Reindeer Herders in 2021 in Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug - Ugra.

Also, an agreement on cooperation between the Northern Forum and the Ethnosport Federation of Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug – Ugra (see Annex 4) was signed, under which the parties intend to join efforts for the preservation, development and promotion of national sports and traditional games, as well as to study the issue of signing a Memorandum of Understanding between the Northern Forum and the Ethnosport World Society (EWS) and the establishment of the Standing Advisory Council for the traditional games of indigenous peoples of the North.

As part of the events a study visits of participants to institutions of the Khanty-Mansiysk were organized. So, Governor of Lapland province Mika Riipi and Member of the Federation Council from Chukotka Autonomous Okrug Anna Otke visited the Ugra Adaptive Sports Center, where the adaptive sports were presented. Also, the Director of the Arctic Portal, Halldór Jóhannsson and Professor of University of Lapland, Lassi Heininen paid a visit to Ugra State University. Thus, participants were given the opportunity to establish contacts and possible cooperation in the future, which is one of the positive and promising results of the event.



## Section 2. EXPENDITURES FOR 2017

In 2016 the Secretariat has been limiting its costs in the first half of the year because most of the members have paid their membership dues in the second half of the year. At present the Secretariat employs Executive Director, Deputy Executive Director, Chief Specialist, Specialist and a part-time Accountant.

Besides payroll, the Secretariat's budget includes the following items of expenditure:

1. To ensure the Secretariat's staff social security, all mandatory payments to the Pension Fund and Social Security Fund were charged to payroll.
2. In accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation and the Labour Code of the Russian Federation, provision is made for vacation travel expenses every two years for those who are employed in Sakha Republic (Yakutia).
3. Travel expenses to represent the Northern Forum at the Arctic Council meetings and for possible participation in the international events on the Arctic issues.
4. The Budget for 2017 also includes funds for holding a meeting of the Working Groups' Chairs in June in Khanty-Mansiysk and General Assembly in November in Krasnoyarsk.
5. Other expenses item implies unexpected expenses, e.g. correspondence and documents express mailing, some additional office equipment, etc.
6. Since all financial operations in the Russian Federation are made in roubles, membership dues from foreign members transferred to the Northern Forum Academy's currency accounts will be converted into roubles. The bank charges a fee for the conversion on the average rate of 0.5% of the amount to be converted. The bank also charges a fee for Academy's accounts service, cash withdrawal, various letters of confirmation, etc.





Call for Projects**

The Northern Forum call for projects (hereinafter referred to as Call) is held with the aim of promoting the socio-economic development of the Northern regions.

The deadline for submitting applications to participate in the Competition is **October 1, 2017**. Organizations can participate in the Program regardless of the form of ownership.

**Projects should correspond to the topics of the Northern Forum Working Groups:**

- Topic 1: Education and Research;
- Topic 2: Culture;
- Topic 3: Business Cooperation in the North;
- Topic 4: Environment and Conservation of Biodiversity;
- Topic 5: Regional Adaptation to Climate Change;
- Topic 6: Development of Energy in the North;
- Topic 7: Assessment of Quality of Life in the Arctic Regions;
- Topic 8: Transportation in the North;
- Topic 9: Health in the North and Social Issues;
- Topic 10: Housing in the Arctic.

**For all topics, priority will be given to projects that:**

- Demonstrate specific outcome. Projects consisting of only conferences, round tables and discussions will NOT be funded.

**Project funds can be used for the following purposes:**

- Conducting campaigns to involve the public in socially important activities;
- Support to solve social problems;
- Payment of salaries and fees directly related to the project, including taxes;
- Payment of transportation expenses directly related to the project;

6. Creative approach, non-trivial, innovative solutions;
7. The adequacy of the requested budget to the nature and scope of the work performed. Efficiency of the project in terms of spending financial resources. Own contribution and the amount of additional funds raised.

*Note: The funding within the Call is limited, and not all proposals can be financed.*

The application must comply with the attached requirements, all sections must be filled. Applications are to be sent by e-mail to the Chair of the Working Group, depending on the topic.

Write simply, briefly and carefully. *Attention!* **The volume of all the materials** submitted by the applicant should not exceed **three pages (10 pt)**. Try not to use vague terms ("many", "very", "sometimes", etc.) and long sentences (more than 30 words).

The entire application is sent as **a single file**. **File name** (maximum of two words) **should match** with either the project name or the name of the organization.

Please save your and our resources, do not include images, signatures and other "heavy" objects, which make uploaded files bigger!

**Project Objectives.** The objectives (what you do) - concrete and measurable results, (logically following from the analysis of the problem, aimed to achieve the goal) that you plan to get in the course of the project, indicating the participants to your activities and the "beneficiaries" of the project.

- **Work plan with the description of methods** (as exactly you will do), using which you plan to solve the problems with a **characteristic of the target group** involved in activities **and timeline** of project's implementation.

**between the International Organization of Northern Regions “Northern Forum” and the Regional public organization “Ethnosport Federation of the Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug – Ugra”**

**Preamble**

The International Organization of Northern Regions “Northern Forum” (hereinafter referred to as the Northern Forum) serves to improve the quality of life of the people of the North by providing the regional governments of Northern countries with opportunities to share knowledge, experience in solving similar problems, supporting sustainable development and implementing social and economic initiatives among northern regions, including through the preservation of the cultural heritage of the indigenous peoples of the North.

The Northern Forum has a long history of cooperation and expresses special needs of the inhabitants of the northern regions. Also, the Northern Forum is a platform for discussions and planning measures aimed at combining the interests of the inhabitants of the North.

Regional public organization “Ethnosport Federation of Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug – Ugra” (hereinafter - Ethnosport Federation) serves the purpose of ethnic sport, including ancestral fun and traditional physical activities, which are an integral part of the cultural heritage of the peoples of the North, cultural and moral education of youth on the basis of ethno-cultural traditions.

**Article 1. Directions of cooperation.**

Taking into account the relevance of the activities for the development of traditional sports, the overall objectives of the organizations, the Parties agreed on the following:

- To unite efforts for preservation, development and popularization of national types of sport, which form the basis of the culture and self-identification of indigenous peoples of the North.
- With a view of common tasks of both parties, directed towards support of Northerners, jointly explore opportunities for attracting financial resources for the development of ethno-sport.
- To carry out cooperation with minimizing possible damage to existing relations and unions;



- To achieve greater success for each of the Parties combining their names and actions, if needed.
- To facilitate the revival and the regular holding of traditional games and festivals in member regions of the Northern Forum.
- contribute to the organization and holding of traditional games as a historically established effective way of physical education of youth and promoting healthy lifestyle.
- Create favourable conditions for cooperation of traditional sport/ethnosport specialists for fulfilling creative and scientific potential of the member regions of the Northern Forum.

## **Article 2. Intentions of the Parties.**

### **Ethnosport Federation intends:**

- disseminate information about the plans, events, news of the Northern Forum among its partners;
- provide the necessary information to the Executive Director of the Northern Forum on request;
- to involve the representatives of NF member regions and business partners in its activities;
- to attend international events as a delegate of the Northern Forum by the request of the NF member regions and the NF Secretariat.

### **The Northern Forum intends:**

- to post information about Ethnosport Federation of the Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug – Ugra on the website of the Northern Forum;
- to disseminate information on the activities of the Ethnosport Federation of Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug – Ugra among the NF member regions and business partners on request;
- to provide the necessary information about the activities of the Northern Forum;
- to involve the representatives of the Ethnosport Federation of Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug - Ugra in the activities of the Northern Forum;
- to involve the representatives of the NF member regions and business partners in activities of Ethnosport Federation of Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug – Ugra;

### **The parties intend to:**

- jointly study the issue of signing a memorandum of understanding between the Northern Forum and the Ethosport World Society (EWS), created



by the of Permanent advisory council of traditional games of indigenous peoples of the North.

### **Article 3. Operation of the Agreement.**

The Agreement comes into force from the moment of its signing by both Parties. The Agreement may be terminated by either of the Parties for any reason, after a period of 90 days from the date of notification of the other Party of the termination of the Agreement.

The agreement was signed on July 1, 2017 in two copies in Russian and English.


